### How Does the Festival Work?

Performances occur in large, circus-type tents in downtown Jonesborough, with general admission seating provided in each tent. Regular programming is scheduled throughout the day in each tent. Attendees simply choose which performances they want to attend. The tents are all located within easy walking distance of each other. A Family Showcase Tent is especially appropriate for school groups. When you pick up your tickets at registration, you will be given a festival program, which will include the daily schedule and a map of the festival grounds.

# 2010 National Storytelling Festival School Day

## School Group Information

Friday, October 1, 2010 is School Day at the 38<sup>th</sup> annual National Storytelling Festival!

A special rate of \$20 is available to organized groups of 15 or more from grades 3–12; a special rate of \$40 is available to college groups of 15 or more.

The above special rates also apply to chaperones, as follows:

- A maximum of 3 teachers/chaperones for every 15 students from grades 3-5.
- A maximum of 2 teachers/chaperones for every 15 students from grades 6-12.
- A maximum of 1 teacher/chaperone for every 15 college students

## Other

Adults beyond this limit may purchase a ticket for \$50 (discounted from \$100). Bus drivers attend free.

**School Day tickets for grades 3-12 are valid for entry into any festival venue for daytime programming only (10 am–5 pm); college group tickets are valid through 10pm. A Family Showcase Tent is especially appropriate for grades 3-12 school day groups.**

## School Group Requirements

- School Day discounts are available to 3rd through 12th and college groups only.
- The group must contain at least 15 students, registered as a group with one transaction.
- For all grades, there must be a minimum of one adult, either a teacher or designated chaperone, for every 15 students. The maximum number of teachers or chaperones who can receive the \$20 price is 3 adults for every 15 students for grades 3–5, 2 adults for every 15 students for grades 6–12, and 1 teacher/chaperone for every 15 college students.
- Student group attendance will be limited and selected on a first come, first served basis.

## Registration forms and payment

Registration forms and payment must be received by September 17, 2010.

School Day tickets are limited, so please send your registration in as soon as possible. If there is a change in the registration totals after your form is submitted, contact Customer Service by September 24, 2010. Except for emergencies, refunds will not be available at Festival Registration.

## Upon Arrival at Festival

Festival Registration is located in the Historic Jonesborough Visitors Center on Boone Street. **Only one adult should pick up a group's registration packet.** Be sure all chaperones are aware of the designated contact person. The packet will include admission tickets and festival programming schedules. Packets are located at the Adjustments Table. **We cannot hold part of a registration packet for late arriving members of group.** We recommend that the group designate a meeting place and time if part of the group is traveling separately.

## While in Jonesborough

We recommend that students remain on the Festival premises. If 3–8 grade students go elsewhere within the town, however, they should be accompanied at all times by a teacher or chaperone. If a student is separated from the group, he/she should report to Festival Headquarters or to the Visitors Center.

## Tent seats cannot be reserved

Please note that seats cannot be reserved or saved within the festival tents. One or more persons cannot save seats for the group.

## During Performance

Please refrain from entering or exiting tents during a performance.
